

CODE OF CONDUCT – Parents/Guardian

Everyone has a role to play in ensuring that Football is free from bullying, verbal, and physical abuse and that it is played in a fair and safe environment.

As leaders and role models, parents/guardian must model the behaviour that they expect their children to follow. It is essential that YOU play your part and follow this Code of Conduct always.

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants always.

2. Never ridicule, criticise or unduly reprimand a player for making a mistake. They do not play intending to make mistakes, this includes your own child.

3. Encourage your child to participate for their own interest and enjoyment.

4. Encourage your child to always play by the rules.

5. Focus on encouraging your child to develop their skills, playing, and enjoying the game and doing their best. Take the emphasis away from winning.

6. Set an example by always role modelling respectful and positive behaviour. Applaud good play by all players and teams.

7. Accept decisions made by the Referees. They are trying to do their best.

8. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical altercations at games.

9. Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials, and administrators.
